Today, we take good internet connection for granted, but without it, so much of the internet's potential would be unrealized. Similarly, connecting to the brain and nervous system offers potential for numerous medical breakthroughs. However, these connections are hampered with problems.

That's where Actuated comes in. Our technology is helping world-class brain researchers improve connections to the brain. In the long term, we see our technology enabling neural researchers to dramatically improve therapy for chronic diseases arising from neural disfunction. Our first entrant in this space is our NeuralGlider® Inserter, which has been well received by the market and is currently being utilized by neural research centers such as University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, Carnegie Mellon University and University of Pittsburgh.

Our GripTract-GITM Endoscopic Tissue Manipulator, a patented minimally invasive alternative to stomach surgery, completed a safety study yielding positive results. We are receiving interest from a growing number of clinicians. A 510(k) submission is planned by end of 2022. Our BabyGentleStickTM Heel Stick Helper, a less painful way to draw blood from neonates, has two IRB-approved clinical studies at Nationwide Children's Hospital and Penn State Children's Hospital that are progressing. A 510(k) submission is planned by end of 2022.

Excited by our future, we doubled our facility's size and added more commercial and clinical expertise. With this expansion, we are growing a new business unit in which Actuated selectively takes on medical device projects which apply our unique expertise in tissue mechanics and device solutions. 
Maureen was awarded the Life Sciences Pennsylvania 2020 CEO of the Year award at the annual awards ceremony in May 2021.

Neural Implant Inserter

+ Over the years, Actuated has developed the know-how and expertise to insert needles into tissue with less trauma and reduced force. This expertise led to the development of the NeuralGlider Inserter. NeuralGlider is helping researchers implant neural devices into the brain with greater precision and less trauma. In the future, the technology will assist clinicians in controlling brain computer interfaces. NeuralGlider is being sold by NeuroNexus, Inc. and Plexon, Inc. The Actuated neural devices research team is working with world-class researchers at Carnegie Mellon, University of Pittsburgh, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC), Lawrence Livermore National Lab, Tulane University, to name a few. UT Dallas and UNC researchers have already published their research using the NeuralGlider Inserter (see www.neuralglider.com).





Feeding Tube Clearing System

+ The TubeClear System has continued to have repeat sales at facilities such as Harborview (Seattle, WA), UC Davis (Sacramento, CA), Omaha VA Medical Center (Omaha, NE). A new customer, NeuroRestorative (Riverton, UT) completed a four week clinical evaluation. By using the TubeClear System, NeuroRestorative not only provided their residents a greater sense of relief, but they also saved over \$8,000 in one month. The NeuroRestorative nurses wrote a white paper about better resident care and cost saving (see www.tubeclear.com). Texas Children's and Baylor University Medical Center are working on IRB submission for a Pediatric Study with the TubeClear System.

Endoscopic Tissue Manipulator

+ The GripTract GI Endoscopic Tissue Manipulator is a patented innovative device that gives clinicians 'fingers' at the end of the endoscope to move tissue improving visualization. It is gaining significant clinical interest due to its ability to provide tissue lifting during procedures. Clinicians at Penn State College of Medicine have worked with the Actuated team to perform safety and efficacy studies. This data will be presented by Dr. E. M. Pauli, Director of Endoscopic Surgery and Chief, Division of Minimally Invasive and Bariatric Surgery, Penn State, during the Next Big Thing Session at the 2022 SAGES Conference in Denver, CO, March 18, 2022. An FDA 510(k) submission is planned for the end of 2022.





Heel Stick Helper




